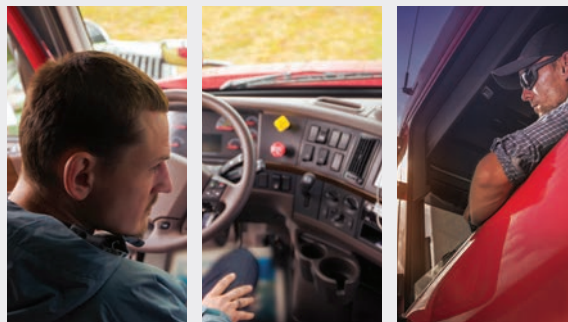

Housing Vouchers for Qualified Veterans: Diesel Driving School offers all eligible veterans a housing voucher which can be redeemed at our dormitory (the school's housing facility) for the full cost of housing in a double occupancy room for the complete length of the student's training period. To qualify, the veteran must have been honorably discharged from the military and submit their form DD214 to the school registrar. This voucher has a value of \$120 per week multiplied by the number of weeks of training. This voucher can only be used for the School's housing facility and cannot be redeemed for cash.

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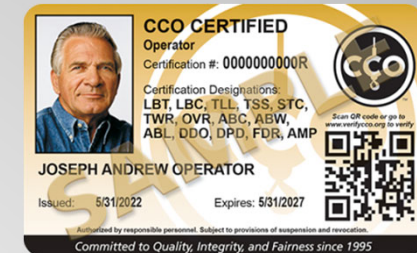
ATS Certification

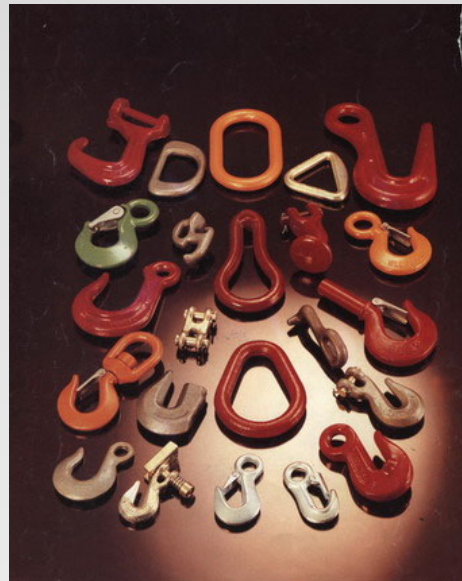
