Informed Consent for Admission for Mental Health/Substance Abuse Assessment and/or Treatment

The Stockbridge-Munsee Health & Wellness Center's Behavioral Health Department, offers a continuum of quality services to meet the specific needs of each individual, couple, and family. We are a community-based, outpatient program providing counseling for children, adolescents, couples, families, and adults. Our staff consists of licensed and certified professionals who are dedicated to supporting you with fulfilling your goals and improving your quality of life.

Please read the following information carefully and ask your counselor to answer any questions you may have.

- 1) Psychotherapy is provided to individuals, couples, families, and/or groups depending on the best therapeutic process available and will be identified in your treatment plan and level of care. You have the right to request a consultation with the consulting psychologist and referrals will be made to community resources and outside providers when SMHWC cannot provide in-house services.
- 2) **We maintain the confidentiality of your information.**
 - a. We cannot or will not release confidential information without your written consent other than some limited exceptions. One exception to this rule is a "Duty to Warn" to protect you and others. If there is a serious and imminent threat of harm yourself or another person, we are required by law to report this to the police. We are also required to report to authorities, for investigation, any evidence of child abuse or neglect. Other exceptions are for the purpose of continuity of care for treatment, such as in the event of an emergency, if we receive a court order for records, and for the SMHWC's treatment, payment, and operations in accordance with our Notice of Privacy Practices.
 - b. Written consents will be required for urine screen results to third parties such as courts, EAP, Probation and Parole.
- 3) A treatment plan will be established based on each individual identified set of goals and desired outcomes. Your active participation is important and beneficial to the outcome of your treatment and the approximate duration will be determined in your treatment plan and level of care.
- 4) Treatment alternatives
- 5) Possible outcomes and side effects of treatment recommended in treatment plan
- 6) All clients have the right to ask questions about your treatment and file a complaint if you are dissatisfied with the services you receive. The Stockbridge-Munsee Health & Wellness Center Behavioral Health Department shall provide each client with a copy of the Client Rights and

Grievance Procedure for Community Services. The SMHWC also has an internal process for grievances. At any time, a client may request to view the department's policies and procedures on grievances and operations.

If you have private insurance, Badger Care, or are eligible for Indian Health Services (IHS), we will bill for services at the established rate. Direct health care services can be provided to eligible enrolled Federally Recognized Native Americans without being responsible for billable charges. You may set up a financial agreement with the business office for making payments on any outstanding bills.

The Stockbridge-Munsee Health & Wellness Center Behavioral Health Department may discontinue services, and/or you may be discharged under the following circumstances:

- You voluntarily withdraw from counseling
- You no longer meet criteria for level of care
- All treatment goals have been met
- You fail to demonstrate an interest in actively pursuing treatment goals, for example, missing appointments.



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- You have no activity within a 60-day period unless prior arrangements have been made to keep your chart open
- You have a delinquent patient account and/or inability to pay
- If the client has 3 no shows or late cancellations within a 3-month period, they may be discharged from services for 3 months.
- As a result of your behavior, as it reasonably relates to your diagnostic symptoms and upon recommendation of your therapist

I have read and understand the above and have had the opportunity to ask questions about this information. I acknowledge I have been given a copy of the Client Rights and Grievance Procedure for Community Services. I may request a copy of this signed consent at any time. This informed consent will expire 12 months from the date of signature.

Substance Use Treatment:

Urine/breath drug screening may be recommended or required in order for your therapist to have a good understanding of your current substance use condition and to make an accurate diagnosis. There may be cases where treatment may not be recommended without a drug screen. Submitting to a drug screen may incur costs as defined previously in this document. Release of drug screen results to a court, attorney or probation agent may result in legal actions that Stockbridge-Munsee Behavioral Health cannot anticipate. Release of drug screen results may be restricted on your release of information document which the therapist will go over with you.
