Households which live within the Stockbridge-Munsee reservation boundaries, if living in Shawano County you need at least one household member that is enrolled in any federally recognized tribe and meets the income eligibility guidelines. Eligibility is based on the income of all household members 18 and older. The Food Distribution Program is an alternative to Food Shares. You cannot receive Food Shares and Commodities within the same month.

Kinship Care-715-793-3003

The kinship program provides families, and relative caregivers with information and referrals regarding available resources and services. It also provides personal instruction, develops support plans, demonstrates appropriate educational activities; and delivers a research-based curriculum to caregivers regarding child development and related issues.

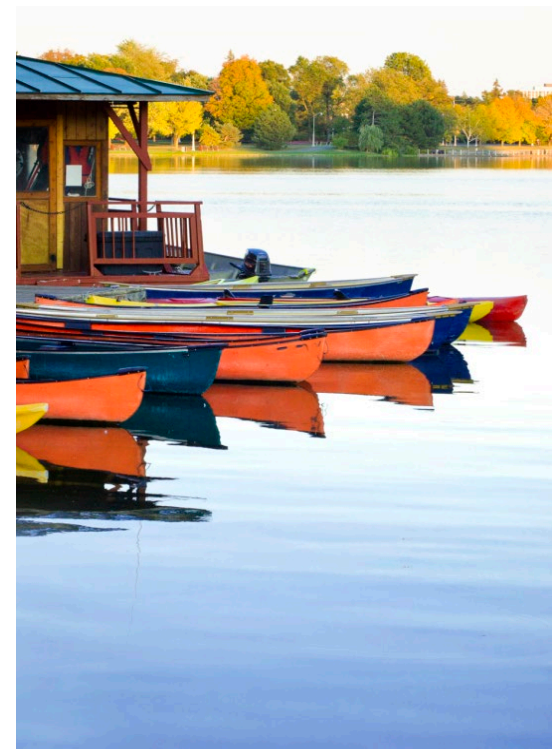
