



Wis-MAC Program Veterans in Healthcare

Heroes for Healthcare is a nonprofit organization administering the **Wisconsin Military Medics and Corpsmen (Wis-MAC) Program** for transitioning medics, corpsmen, and medical technicians to work in civilian healthcare.

Program Requirements

- Wis-MAC is an innovative pathway for medics, corpsmen and medical technicians to work in 18 partner hospitals in Wisconsin. Wis-MAC participants to work under supervision of RN, ANP, DR., PA, or podiatrist
- The Wis-MAC scope of practice is at the LPN level, and average hourly rate is between \$22 to \$30 dollars
- Participants must be 12 months post-discharge, with an honorable or general discharge status
- Required to enroll in educational program to obtain Wisconsin license in desired healthcare career
- Eligible to work in an in-patient, outpatient healthcare facility, or a community-based residential care facility
- **Eligible to remain in program until Wisconsin license is obtained**
